#### ORDER:

The e-District Project is one of the State Mission Mode Projects (SMMPs) being implemented under National e-Governance Plan (NeGP). The objective of e-District Mission Mode Project is Electronic Delivery of identified high volume Citizen Centric Services at District and sub-district levels.

- 2. Administrative approval was accorded for implementation of the "Pilot e-District Project" in 6 Districts viz., *Krishnagiri, Ariyalur, Coimbatore, Perambalur, Tiruvarur and The Nilgiris* of Tamil Nadu. The Government have successfully implemented the pilot e-District Project in six districts mentioned above. The services provided by four Departments i.e. Revenue, Backward Classes & Most Backward Classes, Adi Dravidar & Tribal Welfare and Social Welfare have been made online and services are offered to citizens through the e-District Portal. Many such services of various Departments are being identified and these services are proposed to be made available Online in future.
- 3. The Government of Tamil Nadu was requested to furnish DPR for the State Wide Rollout of e-District Mission Mode Project in the remaining 26 Districts of the State. Accordingly, the DPR was submitted to DeitY, Government of India after approval of the State Apex Committee.

- 4. In the reference 3rd read above, Administrative approval has been accorded by Government of India for "Implementation of the e-District Mission Mode Project" in the remaining 26 Districts of Tamil Nadu at a total estimated outlay of Rs. 6685.67 lakhs (Rupees Sixty Six Crore Eighty Five lakhs and Sixty Seven Thousand only) (DeitY share-Rs.4822.34 Lakhs and ACA-Rs.1863.33 Lakhs) to be implemented by Tamil Nadu e-Governance Agency (TNeGA) over a period of 4 years.
- 5. As per the guidelines for National Rollout of e-District Mission Mode Project, the District e-Governance Society (DeGS) is the Implementation Agency at District level. As per the guidelines of Government of India and as the first step towards implementation of State Wide Rollout of e-District Project, Government have ordered the formation of District e-Governance Society (DeGS) headed by the District Collector with District level officials as members in all the Districts in the reference 2nd read above.
- 6. Further to this, orders are now issued enabling the rollout of State Wide e-District Project at a total estimated outlay of Rs. 6685.67 lakhs in the remaining 26 Districts of the State viz., Chennai, Cuddalore, Dharmapuri, Dindigul, Erode, Kancheepuram, Kanniyakumari, Karur, Madurai, Nagapattinam, Namakkal, Pudukkottai, Ramanathapuram, Salem, Sivagangai, Thanjavur, Theni, Thoothukudi, Tiruchirapalli, Tirunelveli, Tiruppur, Tiruvallur, Tiruvannamalai, Vellore, Villupuram and Virudhunagar. The Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu e-Governance Agency and the concerned District Collectors are instructed to take necessary action to implement the roll-out of the e-District Project successfully.
